## AZCOURTHELP.ORG

### Court Forms, Processes, and Information

- 833,801 users accessed the site.
- 100,089 users accessed the site in a language other than English.
- 1,032 users were helped by a Law Librarian via the Live Chat program.
- 100,770 downloads of court forms.
- 1,398 hours were spent by users watching video content.
- 58 legal clinics were promoted.

## LAWFORKIDS.ORG

LawForKids helps those under the age of 18 to learn about their rights and responsibilities in Arizona. The site also hosts many of the Foundation and AOC partnership programs, including iCivics Arizona.

## ICIVICS ARIZONA

- 215,536 served through both Arizona and national iCivics.
- 10 middle schools and 17 high school for a total of 241 students participated in the regional iCivics Arizona E-tournament.



## MOCK TRIAL AND TEEN COURT

- 114 students participated in the State Mock Trial Competition with Veritas of Phoenix placing first and heading to the National competition in Delaware.
- 2,016 you participated in the Teen Court programs.

## KIDS VOTING ARIZONA AND THE KV LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

- Kids Voting posters and family booklets were created to engage youth.
- The Kids Voting Leadership Council consists of 16 middle and high school students. They attended 7 field trips this grant period hearing from Secretary Fontes, Clean Elections, Maricopa County Recorder's Office, PBS, Pima County Elections Department and Senators Mendez and Fernandez



## LAW DAY CONTEST

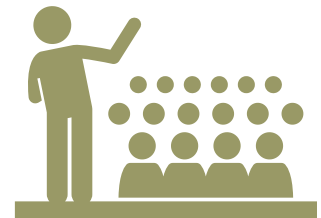
The Law Day Contest engages K-12 youth in a civics-based contest based on a yearly contest theme and rules. The theme for this year was, “If I were running for office, my campaign promise would be...”



- 347 total students participated.
- An AZ Law Day Contest history page was added to highlight the entries created by student winners from past years.

## PROJECT CITIZEN

- 425 students participated in Project Citizen showcases
- 101 students participated in the state showcase with topics from littering, homelessness, groundwater pollution and gun violence.



## WE THE PEOPLE

- 2,146 students participated in competitions and showcases.
- 213 student participated in the state competition with Corona Del Sol of Tempe placing first and going on to the national competition.

## SUMMER INSTITUTES

- A We the People Summer Institute was held June 10-14, 2024, for 20 educators.
- A We the People Summer Institute was held June 17-21, 2024, for 40 educators.
- An American Civic Education Programs Summer Institute was hosted July 10-12, 2023, for 7 new We the People Arizona educators.
